

The overriding response—the internet: "Messages sent, words not spoken", "lack of in-depth communication", "words sent that cut like knives", "Young people can hide behind keyboards".

April 13th & 14th

Watt (composer) & Dale Collier (multi-media artist), Flipsiders will create a series of dance installations focusing on "cyber-isolation".

Digital media gives impressions of closeness, instant friends, whilst promoting shallow connections.

Cyber- bullying is placing youth at greater risk and isolation.


