

"The Flipside Project", shortlisted for a 2016 Australian Dance Award for Outstanding Achievement in Youth Dance, has most recently engaged choreographers: Catapult's Artistic Director: Cadi McCarthy, Kristina Chan, Marnie Palomares, Rhiannon Newton, Yukino McHugh, Brandon Atoui and Harrison Elliot.

The work performed includes choreography spanning six intensive programs, including original work created for 'In Search of the Lost Things' Maitland Regional Art Gallery, Hunter Dance Festival and most recently, for 'Manning the Fort' at Fort Scratchley, a co-production with Tantrum Youth Arts.

The full-length work PUSHING BOUNDARIES is performed by over 40 participants from across the Hunter aged 8 to 22 and includes members of the Catapult UTurn Program, as well as Tafe Graduates from RIPA.

Choreographed to an original soundtrack composed by James Maher and Zackari Watt, the show will also include visual design by Jessica Coughlan in collaboration with Cadi Mccarthy.

The Flipside Project is Supported by Arts NSW, the NSW Department of Education and Communities, the City of Newcastle, Ausdance NSW, the University of Newcastle and Hunter TAFE.
